SUMMARY

Professor David Greenaway is Vice-Chancellor of the University of Nottingham. This is one of the United Kingdom's largest comprehensive, research intensive Universities, with an annual turnover in excess of £520 million, 32,000 students and 7,000 staff. In addition to its four Campuses and three teaching hospitals in the East Midlands, Nottingham has Campuses in China and Malaysia with a further 9,000 students between them.

Professor Greenaway's public service commitments are extensive. He has been Chairman of the Armed Forces Pay Review Body (2004-10) which advises the Prime Minister and Secretary of State for Defence on the pay and conditions of the UK's Armed Forces; a Member of that same body (1998-2004); and a Member of the Senior Salaries Review Body (2004-2010). He has held non-executive positions in the National Health Service, including Board Member roles with the Nottingham Health Authority and Nottingham University Hospitals Trust. He has provided advice to a range of Government Departments, including the preparation of an influential report on uninsured driving for the Secretary of State for Transport in 2006. He is currently a Deputy Lieutenant of the County of Nottinghamshire and Member of the Government's Asia Task Force.

Professor Greenaway's service to the professional community includes appointments to three Research Assessment Panels (1996, 2001 and 2008) including twice as Chair of the Panel; appointment to the Council of ESRC (1998-2002); appointment to a Technology Foresight Panel; and membership of the Council and Executive of the Royal Economic Society.

Professor Greenaway is an Economist, whose expertise lies in international trade and cross-border investment. He has published over 150 papers in leading peer reviewed journals since 1980 and has authored, co-authored or edited 39 books. He is a former Associate Editor of the *Economic Journal* and current Managing Editor of *The World Economy*. He has acted as an Economic Advisor and Consultant to the major international agencies, including The World Bank, OECD, WTO and United Nations.
